

Dr. Julian Webber, BDS, MS, DGDP, FICD. Born 1952

After qualifying from Birmingham Dental School, UK in 1974, Dr. Webber worked as an Associate in a National Health Service Practice for two years before continuing his education at Northwestern University Dental School, Chicago, Illinois, USA. As the recipient of the prestigious Charles Freeman Scholarship of the American Dental Society of Europe he was the first UK dentist to receive a Master of Science degree in Endodontics and returned to the UK in 1978.

Dr. Webber has held teaching positions both at Guys Hospital and Eastman Dental Schools in London whilst maintaining a practice limited to Endodontics in central London since 1978. In October 2002, he opened the Harley Street Centre for Endodontics, a purpose built state of the art practice and teaching facility.

Dr Webber devotes much time to teaching and writing having contributed to numerous journals and textbooks on Endodontics and extensively lectured around the world. His major lectures include the British Dental Association, the British Endodontic Society, The Irish Dental Association, the American Association of Endodontists, the European Society of Endodontology, the Dutch Endodontic Society, The Belgian Dental Association, The French Endodontic society, The French Dental Association, Arab Dentistry (Dubai), AAEDC (Dubai), the Portuguese Dental Association, the Malaysian Society of Endodontology , FDI Dubai, Singapore, Australia, Ukraine Dental Association and the Serbian Dental Association and Endodontic Society. Dr. Webber is a former President of the British Endodontic Society, a member of the American Association Endodontists, European Society of Endodontology, a member of both the American Dental Societies of London and Europe, a member of the Pierre Fauchard Academy and a Fellow of the International College of Dentists. He is a faculty member of the Pacific Endodontic Research Foundation in San Diego, California, USA where he has perfected and taught techniques on Microscope conventional and surgical Endodontics. He is also a visiting professor at the University of Belgrade, Serbia and Montenegro.

In 1998, he became Editor in Chief of **Endodontic Practice** journal, a clinical endodontic journal which has rapidly grown into a world leader in its field with a large circulation both in the UK and worldwide. He is also a clinical advisor to Private Dentistry journal.

Dr. Webber's lecture series " The Root to Success" which started in 1997 has been attended by nearly 3000 dentists in the UK and abroad in such places as Australia, Holland, Belgium, Portugal, Israel, Ireland, South Africa, Spain, Mexico, Switzerland, Russia, Brazil, Chile, China, India, Malaysia, Singapore, Hong Kong.. All these courses have been followed up with Hands on days to over 1000 participants so far.
